Good Morning Ambrose,

Thank you for **your email to the Premier**, we are happy to follow up on his behalf and provide an update. Following the May 21 storm, the ministry deployed twenty Provincial Disaster Assessment Teams to assess damage across Central and Eastern Ontario. The teams found **most of the damage to private property was insured**, although some larger properties experienced tree damage that is not insured and is not eligible for the Disaster Recovery Assistance for Ontarians (DRAO) program.

The assessment process for the DRAO program as a result of the May 21st storm is now complete, and the DRAO program has been activated in **a qualifying area of Uxbridge**. No other areas were identified that met the **activation criteria**.
