Residential brush can be dropped off at any Peterborough County public works depot for free.

- Douro Depot – 713 County Road 4
- Buckhorn Depot – 2467 County Road 36
- Havelock Depot – 649 County Road 46
- Millbrook Depot – 1111 County Road 10
- Centreline Depot – 1275 County Road 24

The County is providing this service as part of the wind storm cleanup and is available for residents and not commercial or industrial brush.
